


#### A big thank you!

#### **Summer Trails**

Join us on the 6th August as we launch our summer trails!

Are you looking for something fun and free to do over the summer holidays? Join us at YMCA Eastleigh from **2pm-4pm** on **Saturday 6th August** as we launch our summer trails!



We've put together some History & Nature trails around NSP. These app based trails, using the 'Actionbound' app (which can be downloaded onto your smartphone - paper copies will be available from the YMCA cafe for those without), will take you around various parts of the park to teach you all about the history of the site and the nature that you can find here. The first trail will be released during our launch event, with subsequent new trails released on the 13th and then the 20th August. Each trail will take around 45 mins - 1 hour to complete.

As well as the trail, we'll be hosting a FREE craft event in the main hall of the YMCA where you can paint rocks and make bug hotels out of plastic bottles. You won't want to miss it!
